Upon request, a “bag lunch” for a field Trip will be prepared for your child by our Food Service Department. The approved lunch will follow the USDA’s guidelines for the National School Lunch Program and will consist of:

Peanut Butter **or** *SunButter & Jelly Sandwich (on Wheat Bread)
Baby Carrots w/Ranch Dip
Fresh Apple
Kikkoman Pearl Organic Soy Milk (Chocolate **or** Vanilla) **or** Bottled Water
Napkin/Straw

You “must” pre-order this meal at least one day prior to your child’s field trip.

***SUNBUTTER:** Made on equipment that processes soybeans. **Processed in a peanut and tree nut free facility.** Contains **“NO”** peanuts. Made from fresh-roasted sunflower seeds.

In order to avoid any foodborne illness, this “bag lunch” must be kept in a cooler with ice packs to maintain a “safe” holding temperature. This cooler, if supplied by the Food Service Department will be picked up in the Middle School Kitchen shortly before your child’s field trip departure and returned immediately upon your child’s arrival back at school.
